The first piece, "An Albannach", is a reel in G major (one sharp) and common time (C). It consists of four staves of music. The melody is characterized by a series of eighth-note patterns, often with beamed eighth notes, and some sixteenth-note runs. The piece concludes with a final cadence on a whole note G.

Martin Ainsborough's Reel
